Apprentice Requirements:	2 years/3600 hours
Tradesperson Requirements:	3 years/5400 hours
Practical Examination:	Yes

The provincial journeyperson examination for this trade is developed by a committee of worker and employer representatives. Examination content is based on industry's standards and expectations.

To write the provincial journeyperson examination, you must either successfully complete an apprenticeship training program or meet tradesperson eligibility requirements. The pass mark is 70%.

Occupational Skills: maintains tools and equipment; cleans, sanitizes and disinfects; performs routine tasks; consults with client.	41%
Skin Care: examines skin; conditions skin; performs facial; removes hair; makeup and enhancement applications.	40%
Nail Care: assesses hand, foot and nail health; manicures; pedicures; performs specialized services; finishes nail.	19%
